Environmental Protection Amendment (Banning Plastic Bags and Other Things) Bill 2017

A Bill for

An Act to amend the Environmental Protection Act 1986 to -

- restrict the supply of plastic bags, balloons, plastic drinking straws and polyethylene and polystyrene packaging; and
- prohibit the supply of products containing plastic microbeads, and for incidental and related purposes.
