### QUESTION WITHOUT NOTICE (Of which some notice has been given)

Thursday, 30 August 2012

Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Mental Health representing the Minister for Environment.

With regard to the membership of the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) Board and the development of the EPA Report and Recommendations into the proposed Browse Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Precinct at James Price Point north of Broome, I ask:

1. When did EPA Board members Dr Chris Whittaker and Mr Denis Glennon commence to hold Woodside shares?
2. On what date did the EPA provide its Report and Recommendations on the proposed Browse LNG precinct to the Minister for Environment, pursuant to Section 44 of the Environmental Protection Act?
