Hon. Robin Chapple to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Mines and Petroleum.

I refer to the period since the RADARS (Reform and Development at Resources Safety) strategy was established by the Department of Mines and Petroleum in 2010, and I ask:

- (1) What has been the total number of reported incidents where an injured worker was absent from work for 2 weeks or more?
 - (2) How many of these reported incidents have been assessed by an associated site visit by a safety inspector?
 - (3) How many of these reported incidents resulted in enforcement action?
 - (4) How many of these reported incidents have an associated "investigation file"?
