1278. Hon Robin Chapple to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Energy.

- (1) Can commercial electricity users in Horizon Power supply areas choose to use stand-alone supply solutions rather than connecting to the Horizon Power network?
- (2) If yes to (1), is there any requirement for competitive tendering for stand-alone power solutions?
- (3) If yes to (2), what is the size of electrical generation or financial level of investment that requires a tender?

Answer

(1) Yes.

(2) This is nothing to do with Horizon Power if the customer doesn't want to connect to the Horizon Power network. They would source their own generation system, based on their own tendering requirements (if they have any).
