1752. Hon Robin Chappie to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Finance.

Regarding the State Supply Commission's *Private Sector Procuring for Public Authorities* supply policy, gazetted date 28 December 2007, 1 ask:

- (a) has this policy been rescinded or changed:
 - (i) if yes to (a), when did this occur; and
 - (ii) if yes to (a), why was it rescinded or what were the changes; and
- (b) what is the supply policy that is currently in its place to ensure accountability and value for money, and when was it gazetted?

Answer

(a-b) The State Supply Commission's (SSC) *Private Sector Procuring for Public Authorities* supply policy was rescinded with effect from 1 July 2014 following a review of all SSC policies.

The SSC's current *Value for Money* policy was gazetted on 28 December 2007.

The SSC's revised *Probity and Accountability* policy was gazetted on 27 June 2014
