2850. Hon Robin Chappie to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Energy.

- (1) Does Horizon Power require all personnel to wear protective clothing when on site at a Horizon Power power station?
- (2) If no to (1), why not?
- (3) If yes to (1), what are the clothing and safety requirements to be worn?
- (4) Do the requirements vary from area to area?
- (5) What are the penalties or procedures for personnel who fail to comply with the clothing and/or safety requirements?
- (6) If the penalties or procedures involve suspension or discipline, how many personnel have been suspended or disciplined?

Answer

- (1)-(2) Not all staff are required to wear protective clothing. The requirement of protective clothing to be worn on a Horizon Power managed and operated Power Station site is very much dependent on the activity that is completed by the individual and the risks associated with that activity.
- (3) Not applicable.
- (4) The requirements vary dependent on activity performed.
- (5) For not following safety standards personnel are open to counselling and depending on the seriousness of the indiscretion, disciplinary proceedings.
