(1) Will the Minister provide a detailed explanation of how the Department will ensure that leaseholders will remove feral goats when their leases expire on 30 June 2015, including how males and females will be separated for transportation, and where they will be transported to?

**Answer**

(1) No.

(2) It is anticipated that the majority of pastoral leases will be renewed on 1 July 2015.

Where a lease is renewed, the pastoral lessee will continue to be responsible for controlling feral animals, including goats.

Where a pastoral lease is not renewed it will become unallocated Crown land on 1 July 2015. In these cases control of feral animals, including goats, will be the responsibility of the Department of Parks and Wildlife.
