C522. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Housing representing the Minister for Regional Development

I refer to the regional reform process being led by Mr Grahame Searle, and ask:

1. Please provide a breakdown of expenditure since the process began in 2015.
2. Has this money come out of the \$150 million *Royalties for Regions Regional Reform Fund*?
3. If not, where has the money spent so far on the process come from?

Answer

I thank the Member for some notice of this question

1. From 1 July 2015 – 18 May 2016
 - (i) Salary \$1 842 965
 - (ii) Non salary \$ 860 461
2. No
3. Half of the Regional Services Reform Unit costs is funded through general Royalties for Regions (not the Regional Reform Fund) and the other half is funded through a transfer of funding from the ten most significant State Government agencies in terms of human services delivery in the Kimberley and Pilbara.
