West Australian politicians welcome the Victorian Dying with Dignity Legislation.

The cross party 'Dying with Dignity' supporters in Western Australia vowed to closely follow the lead of the Victorian Parliament and introduce legalisation to allow the terminally ill access to assisted dying.

A working group consisting of Alannah McTiernan (Labor), Tony Simpson (Liberal) and Robin Chapple (Greens), has been using the work done in South Australia and Victoria to expedite action in WA.
