1. Has access to Boodarie Landing and Kariyarra Island been restricted?
2. If yes, why?
3. What is the intention behind restricting access to this sacred place?
4. Is the restriction extended to Traditional Owners?
5. Are there any development plans for the Boodarie Landing or Kariyarra Island sites at this stage?
