## 1659. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Regional Development representing the Minister for State Development, Jobs and Trade

In the 2016 Health Risk Assessment (HRA) prepared for the Department of Health by Toxikos, the Executive Summary stated "there is sufficient evidence of potential impacts on human health from dust, specifically PM10 in the Toxikos HRA to warrant dust management controls and strategic land-use planning to reduce community exposure to dust", referring to recommendations in this HRA, I ask:
