**C011. Hon Robin Chappie to the Minister for Environment representing the Minister for Transport**

I refer to the Great Northern Highway from Broome to Derby and ask:

1. What is the cost or estimated cost to repair the road?
2. When will it be completed?
3. Is it being repaired to the same standard as it was previously repaired?
4. If yes to (3), is the Minister confident it is being repaired to withstand another flood?

**Answer**

1. The estimated cost to repair the flood damage to Great Northern Highway (GNH) between Broome and Derby is \$14M
2. The majority of the Flood Damage Repairs have been completed. There are some minor works outstanding that will be completed in 2019.
3. The majority of the road will be reconstructed back to the same standard with some sections widened to 11m pavement width.
4. The road has been designed to withstand normal design rainfall events for that region.
