## C538. Hon Robin Chappie to the Leader of the House representing the Premier

I refer to the State Agreement Act governing operations by Mineral Resources at Koolyanobbing and ask:

- 1. Does the Minister agree that a rise in iron ore prices has delivered additional revenue to the Government?
- 2. Does the Minister acknowledge that companies engaged in iron ore mining are making a significantly increased profit as a result of increased iron ore prices?
- 3. If yes to (2), does the Minister agree that the current agreement between the Government and Mineral Resources for large royalty and wharfage discounts is providing a less beneficial deal for the WA tax payer?
- 4. What will the Minister do to address the extremely generous subsidies for mining companies?

## Answer

- (1)-(2) Yes.
- (3) The support arrangement provided to Mineral Resources Ltd continues to provide jobs and other benefits to Western Australia by enabling the continuation of a mining operation that was otherwise going to cease ahead of schedule.
- (4) The Government will continue to honour the agreement reached with Mineral Resources Ltd.
