
C1647. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Environment

I refer to question without notice 1266., which was asked on Tuesday, 29 October 2019, and refer to answer number 3 of that question relating to the site known as the big goanna petroglyph on Murujuga and ask.

1. Did the minister investigate what has caused the pH to change on that site?
2. If no to (1) why not?
3. If yes to (1) what were the findings of that investigation?
4. If yes to (1) who was responsible for the dramatic change in the pH of the test site?
5. Will any action be taken against the perpetrator?

Answer

1. -5. I have requested the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation to investigate this matter. This investigation is ongoing and I expect to have the report in due course. I commit to tabling this report once finalised.
