
2841. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Environment representing the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs

I refer to the Kimberley Region, as defined by the cumulative area falling within the boundaries of the Shires of Broome, Derby-West Kimberley, Halls Creek and Wyndham-East Kimberley, and I ask:

- (a) can the Minister please table a map outlining all current Indigenous Protected Areas, falling within the Kimberley region;
- (b) can the Minister please table a map of the current boundaries of the Uunguu Indigenous Protected Area (UIPA);
- (c) has any application been made to redefine the boundaries of the UIPA:
 - (i) if no to (c), has your Department been involved in any discussions, formal or otherwise, about redefining the boundaries of the UIPA;
 - (ii) if yes to (c), when was that application made and what was the nature of the application; and
 - (iii) if yes to (c(i)), on what occasions were these discussions held, and what was the nature of those discussions; and
- (d) what is the process for changing the boundaries of an Indigenous Protected Area, and from which statutory bodies are permissions required?

Answer

(a)-(d) The Indigenous Protected Areas program is managed by the Federal Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment.
