CORONAVIRUS — REGIONAL HEALTH CAMPUSES — MINING AND PASTORAL REGION

348. Hon ALISON XAMON to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Health:

I ask this question on behalf of Hon Robin Chapple, who is away from the chamber on urgent parliamentary business.

I refer to the Mining and Pastoral Region and its major population centres.

- (1) Which hospitals in this region have an intensive care unit?
- (2) What is the capacity of and number of beds in those wards referred to in (1)?
- (3) Does the minister have a strategy for administering specialised health care in a regional WA context in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak in a regional population centre?
- (4) If yes to (3), would the minister please table the document?
