

(c) Industrial water users may source water from scheme and/or self-supplied water sources. Table 3 lists the water consumption by volume of the top ten industrial consumers of both Water Corporation scheme water (“Customers”) and groundwater or surface water (“Licensees”) that take water under the *Rights in Water and Irrigation Act 1914*.

Note that the ‘-’ entry in the 2019 column of Table 3 denotes that metered water use for the particular industrial water user has not yet been recorded by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.

(d) The volume of water supplied by source (Table 4) includes water sourced in the Perth and Peel region and exported to the Goldfields and Agricultural Region Water Supply Scheme and parts of the South West. The source locations other than for the Water Corporation Integrated Water Supply Scheme desalination plants are numerous and include all dams, bores and other water sources.
