## ABORIGINAL CULTURAL MATERIAL COMMITTEE - QUORUM

## 966. Hon ROBIN CHAPPLE to the minister representing the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs:

I refer to part V of the Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972, in particular sections 28 to 32.
(1) At a meeting of the Aboriginal Cultural Material Committee, understanding that there must be a quorum of five, how many of those five can be ex officio or deputy ex officio attendees?
(2) At a meeting of the ACMC, understanding that there must be a quorum of five, how many of those five must be appointed members, including the chair?

## Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The following answer has been provided to me by the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs.
(1) There must be two ex officio members present.
(2) Section 32(1) is silent on appointed members.
